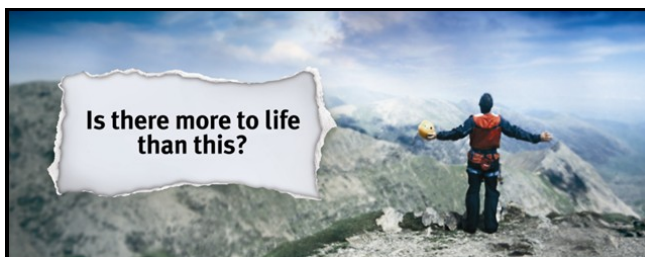
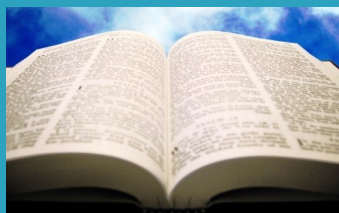


Ephesians 4:14-19
