Description

We are looking for a part-time pastor who loves Jesus and loves youth; someone who has a desire to walk alongside young people as they live life and learn to follow Jesus. We are looking for someone who has a heart for discipling youth, equipping youth leaders, and reaching out into our community.

This position is part-time, beginning Aug. 1. We are also seeking a part-time Pastor of Worship Ministries and would gladly combine both positions into a single full-time position for the qualified individual.

We are a mature church of approximately 250 people. We are part of the Conference of BC Mennonite Brethren Churches, adhering to their Confession of Faith and maintaining strong Anabaptist values. We value community life and engagement with our local and global communities. Responsibilities

4. Engage young people in service opportunities in our church, community, and beyond (e.g., mission trips).
5. Ensure that youth are offered consistent and quality biblical teaching.
6. Remain accountable to the Lead Pastor and the Leadership Team, and adhere to the MB Confession of Faith and the church Constitution.

2. Education and/or experience related to youth ministry.
3. Ability to plan, organize, and lead a relational youth program.
4. Ability to motivate, mentor, and equip volunteers.
